

---




Video streaming and recording that surpass expectations. Leave the A/V duties to the professionals and get back to the core priorities of your job.

# Managed Video

---

## Challenges

- Meetings depend on working video
- Clerks and staff are de facto obligated, but video is a distraction from many other responsibilities
- Complex video equipment built on a variety of third-party hardware over generations
- Plan for the unexpected



# Managed Video

---

## Solutions

- Swagit's hands free video streaming makes video an asset instead of a burden
- Integrates with Granicus and third-party agenda management
- Proactive monitoring and alerting
- Specialized support staff who are trained in remote troubleshooting of A/V, network, streaming

# Dynamic Video Production

---



Fully outsource the operation and production of a multicamera broadcast for public meetings, freeing up staff time.

# Dynamic Video Production

---

## Challenges

- Video streaming is only as good as the equipment that feeds it
- Recreate the in-room experience remotely to meet community expectations
- Hybrid meetings go in reverse
- Shared responsibility between clerk, IT, facilities (who are each short staffed), or by unreliable contractors



# Dynamic Video Production

---

## Solutions

1. Fully outsourced remote switching production with hands-free video solutions
2. Multicamera broadcast system
  - Graphics, picture-in-picture
3. Inputs for voting systems, presentation
4. Outputs for video conferencing, overflow rooms, Zoom/hybrid integrations, cable TV

# Engaging Citizens

---



Stream video to social platforms, PEG channels, streaming services, and web portals to immediately expand your audience.

# Engaging Citizens

---

## Challenges

1. Our communities have a different relationship with meetings than we do
2. Constituents are most likely to be concerned about issues that directly affect them
3. Or not at all!



# Engaging Citizens

## Solutions

1. Meet residents where they are by streaming to social sites including Facebook, YouTube, and Twitter/X
2. Deploy robust video features
  - Tools to clip and share video sections
  - Sound Search™ to find specific discussions
3. Stream to set-top devices such as Roku
4. Build linear cable playout channels to keep residents informed

# Captioning and Accessibility

---



Accurate closed captioning enables participation by more members of your community.

# Captioning and Accessibility

---

## Challenges

1. Accessibility needs vary
  - ADA considerations
  - Linguistic considerations
  - Generational preferences and expectations
2. Captioning has historically been prohibitively expensive
3. Captioning needs to be timely and in sync which is technically difficult



# Captioning and Accessibility

---


## Solutions

1. Automated closed captioning is cheap, flexible, and on-par with human captioning
2. Directly integrated and synchronized into live, VOD, and downloaded video
3. Search spoken word and navigate transcripts using Sound Search™
4. Automated translation to increase engagement




# Sound Search™

1. Search the spoken word
2. Find mentions of specific text and concepts across years of meetings
3. Jump directly to the target point in the discussion
4. Text derived from captioning or machine generated speech-to-text



# Navigable Transcript

1. Scroll and navigate meeting discussions based on captioning or speech-to-text transcripts
2. Coarse navigation of meeting discussion topics, also separated by item
3. Download and edit text for minutes






